Seek Improvements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Accepts the status quo and refuses suggestions for improvements.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Identifies ways to do the work better (faster, more safely, etc.) and takes actions to drive improvements forward.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Challenges the status quo and pushes for new goals when the current goal is achieved.
Experiment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Unwilling to try to new things and/or challenge self to do better.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Willing to try new things and adjust based on the outcome.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Supports and encourages peers to try new things, even when it means their work will change.
Learn from Mistakes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Does not try again when things go wrong.• Places blame on others.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reflects on what worked and what didn't and moves on quickly to try something else.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Uses learning from mistakes to improve their work and shares learning with others.
Think Strategically	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Takes information out of context leading to incorrect conclusions.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Is able to think through and understand implications of actions and decisions.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Proactively identifies opportunities beyond the given task-at-hand and maximizes new opportunities.
