Parking and Transportation

Overview

M Health Fairview is committed to providing a safe and secure patient care environment for patients, family, staff and visitors. Parking is free and easy to find at most of our clinic and office building locations. Each location typically has its own parking policies. Below is a general overview of parking guidelines for our larger locations and hospitals where parking is more complex.

Where Should You Park?

Your manager is your best resource for specific information on where to park. If you are not sure where to park on your first day at your site, see our general guidelines below and be sure to clarify with your manager the parking instructions specific to your location and role at M Health Fairview.

Bethesda Hospital: Free and Contract Parking

• On your first day, park in the Charles Street surface parking lot which is a free lot. If you would like to set up contract parking in the Bethesda Ramp, email *parking@fairview.org*.

Lakes Hospital: Free Parking

• Park in the Green or Yellow parking lots.

Midway Campus: Free and Contract Parking

• Free parking is available in employee designated surface lots. Ramp contract parking is available for \$0.32 cents/hour and key deposit of \$20. Email *parking@fairview.org* for details.

Northland Hospital: Free Parking

• Park in the Southeast and West parking lots.

Ridges Hospital: Free Parking

• On your first day, park in the South lot. Visit the security office to receive a parking sticker and your parking lot assignment either in the lots on the north or south side of the hospital.

St. John's Hospital: Free Parking

• Park in Lot B which is for employees and located north of St. John's Boulevard.

St. Joseph's Hospital: Contract Parking

• On your first day, park in the 10th Street Ramp and email *parking@fairview.org* to set up contract parking.



Southdale Hospital: Contract Parking

Parking contracts are required for all employees wishing to park in a M Health Fairview Ramp.

- On your first day, unless your manager directs you otherwise, park in the East or Skyway ramp.
- After confirming with your manager which parking lot you will park in, please visit the parking office to review parking contracts and site-specific details.

University of Minnesota Medical Center East and West Bank: Contract Parking

Parking contracts are required for all employees wishing to park in a M Health Fairview Ramp.

- On your first day, park in Red or Yellow ramps located on the West Bank near the intersection of 23rd Avenue S and Riverside Avenue. Visit the parking office to review shuttling services and parking contract options.
 - o Parking Office Location: Room F100-1, West Building; Phone: (612) 273-7275
 - East Bank Employees: Plan for extra 30 minutes for contract set up and shuttle transit

Woodwinds Health Campus: Free Parking

• Park in any surface lot not designated for patients. Employees may also park in the North Woods lot, which is across Woodwinds Drive.
